You will receive a total of **three** plants from each category. We recommend choosing one species so you get three plants to create a cluster or drift. If you'd prefer to have a variety of species, you may choose up to three species and get one of each. If you choose two species, we will ask you to select which of those two you would like two plants. The other choice you will get one plant.

Next, you'll select your Keystone plant species. Keystone species are important to include in our gardens. There are many keystone species, but goldenrods and

asters are very important in our region.

The National Wildlife Federation describes keystone species importance here.

Keystone plants are natives that are essential to our ecosystems because they support 90% of the caterpillar species that enable our terrestrial birds to reproduce, as well as all of our specialist native bee species.
